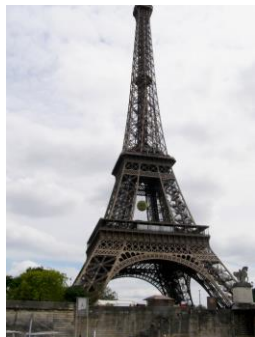


Ten Days in Paris- An Historic Walking Tour
